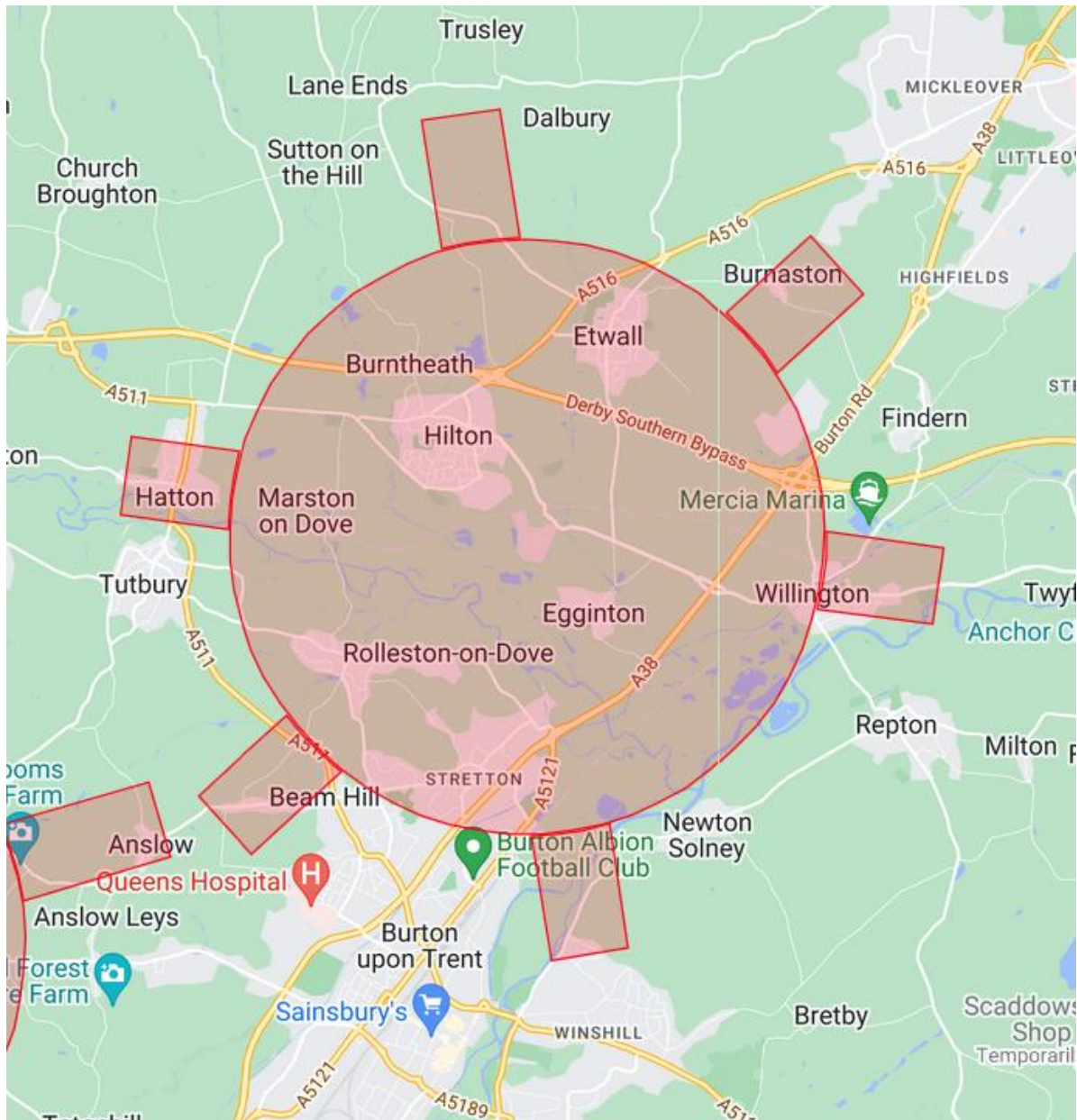


DRONE PILOTS

If you wish to fly a drone anywhere within the Derby Airfield Flight Restricted Zone (FRZ) you must by law seek permission from Derby Airfield.

The FRZ is below:

Please include the following details of your intended flight:

- 1) Your name, address, contact mobile telephone number and email address.
- 2) Your CAA Flyer ID and Operator ID. www.caa.co.uk gives details.
- 3) A copy of your insurance.
- 4) Type and weight of your drone and whether you are a recreational or commercial pilot.
- 5) A map picture of your target area.
- 6) The maximum height you intend to fly to.
- 7) The date of your intended flight.

When this is received and is satisfactory, we will grant permission by email. You must telephone us on the day on **01283 733803** immediately prior to take off and immediately after landing **FOR EACH AND EVERY FLIGHT**. This is because we need to know when you are actually airborne so that if necessary we can warn aircraft in the vicinity by radio. You may be asked to pay a fee – see below.

In emergency conditions we might ask you by telephone to land immediately.

Derby Airfield will do it's best to accommodate your requirements. Please allow us a few days notice so that we can assess your application and if necessary, seek further detail from you.

Recreational pilots	no fee
Commercial pilots with 3 days prior notice	£15 inc. VAT
Commercial pilots with 24 hours prior notice	£30 inc. VAT
